- **Components :**
  - My set consists of 100 chairs.
- **The similarities :**
  - Their commonality lies in their functionality as "seats," and they all contain the same basic components: a seat, a backrest, and legs.
- **The differences:**
  - The design style, color, form, material, and decorative details of the chairs vary significantly. Some chairs have armrests, while others do not. There are also notable differences in the height of the chairs, the angle of the backrest, and the shape of the legs.

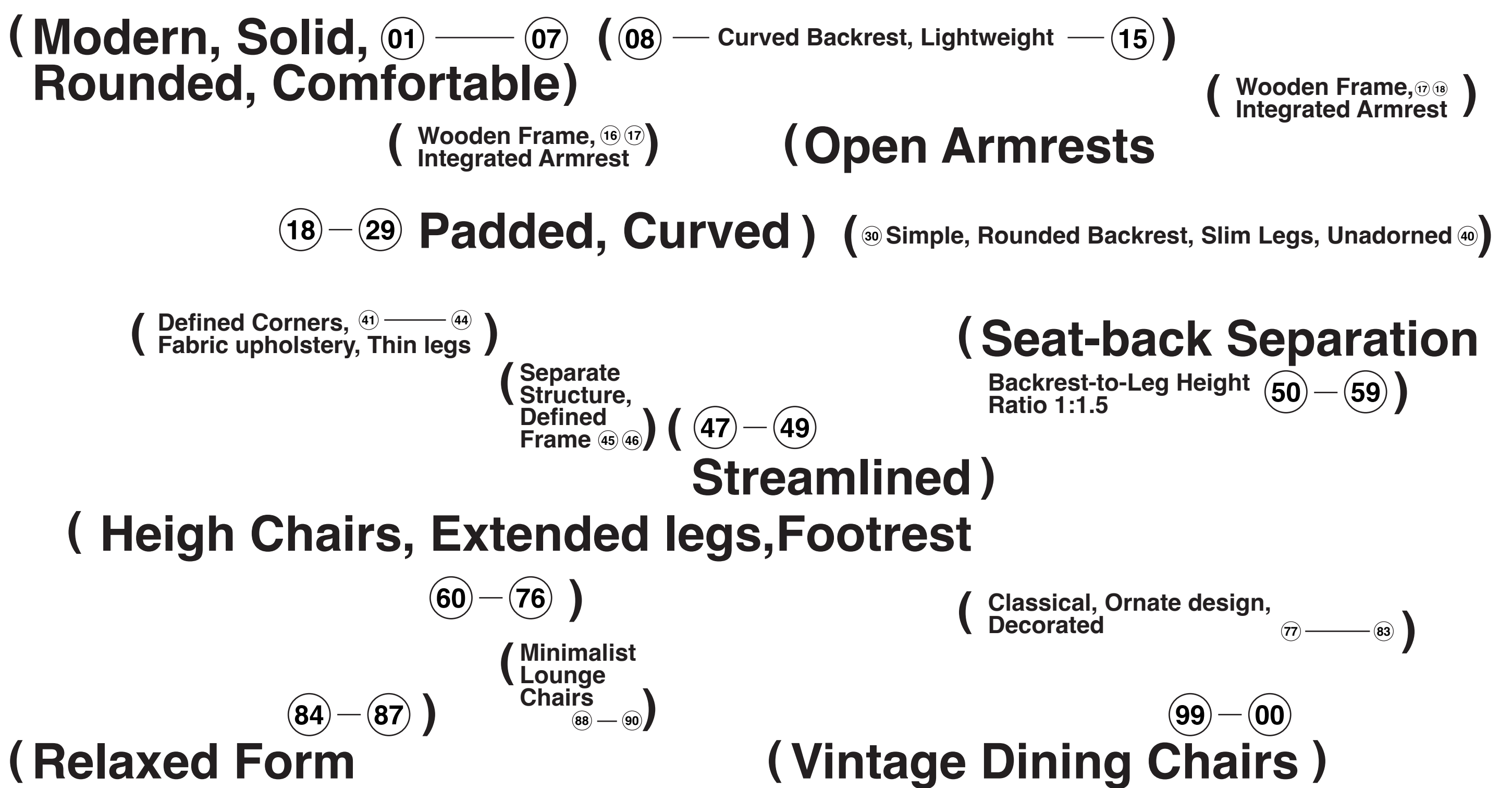
# 2-1      Captioning

I extracted keywords related to chairs, focusing on the proportional relationships between their structural characteristics and components.

Each keyword corresponds to specific formal features; for example, a chair described as 'heavy' is likely to be more solid and wide compared to a 'light' chair.

Through this classification method, similar chairs in terms of structural characteristics can be retrieved using these keywords.







# 3-1 Redrawing

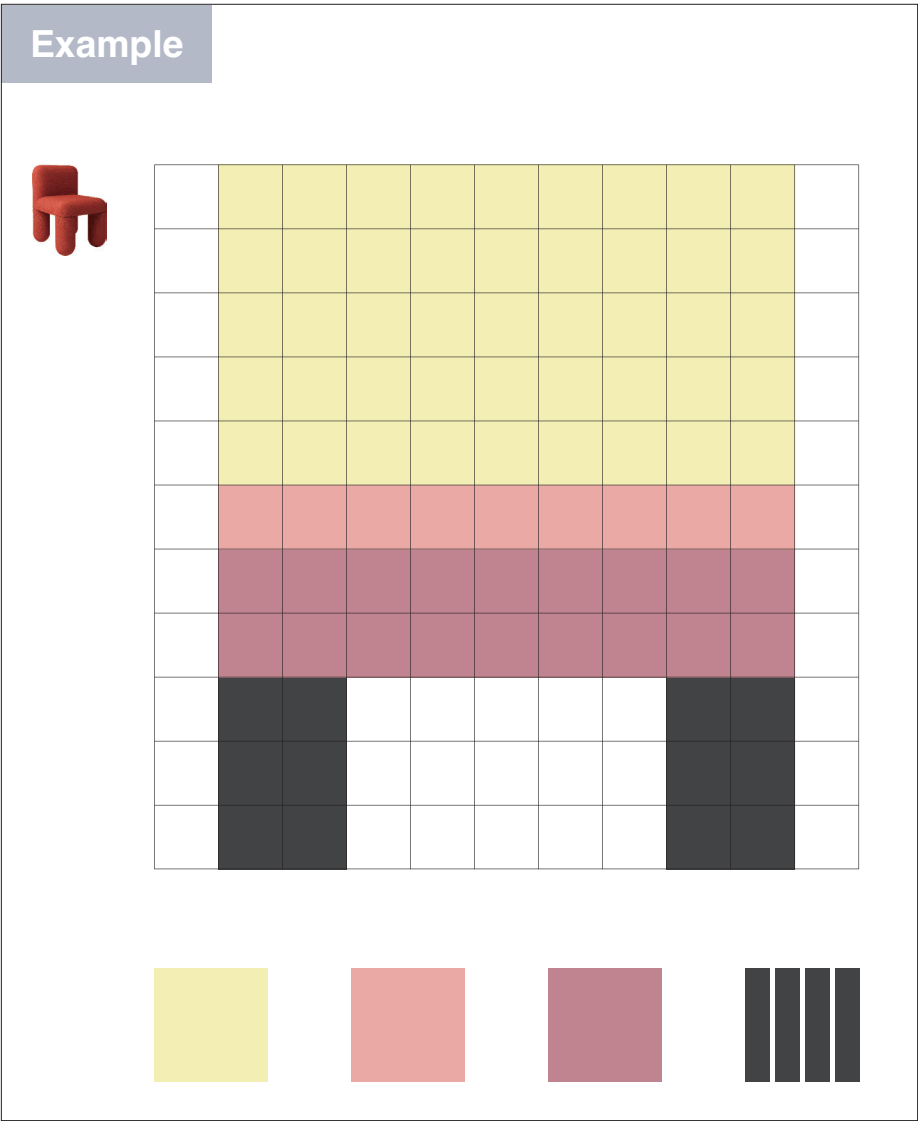
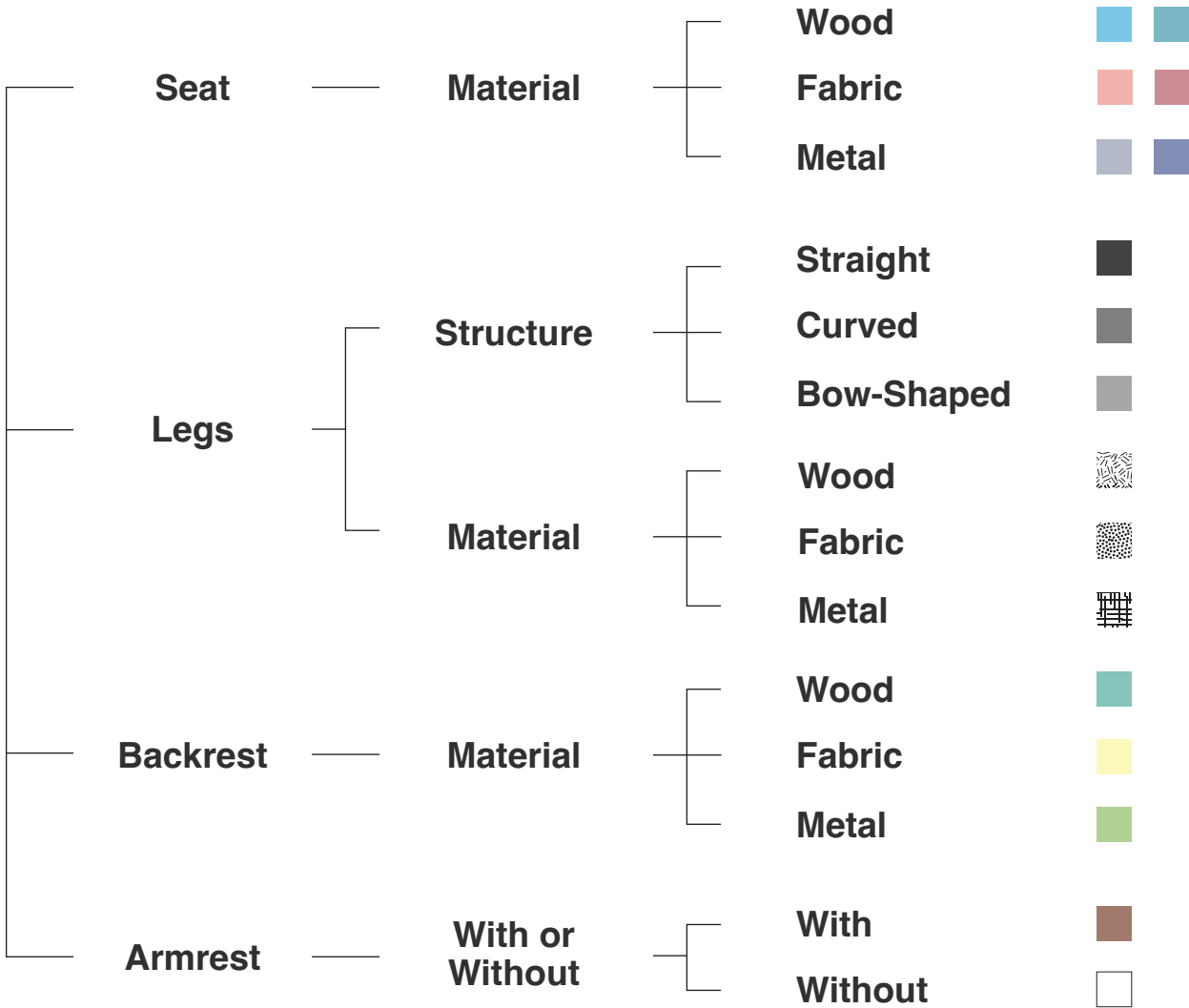
Analyzing feature-recording keywords inspired me to further categorize chairs, and I redrew them in the form of cells. This approach simplifies the shapes of the chairs, making the common characteristics of similar chairs more apparent. At the same time, I attempted to use color for more detailed distinctions, employing color blocks and textures as symbols to further differentiate the materials of each part of the chair.

A separate seat for one person, typically with a back and four legs.



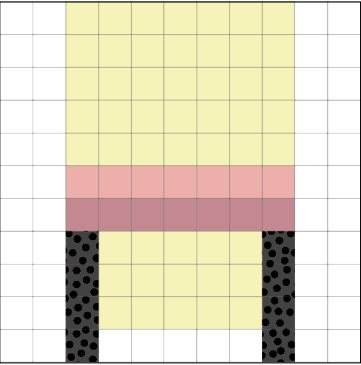
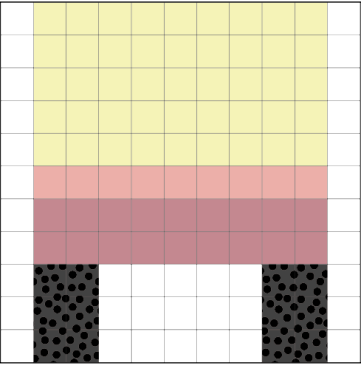
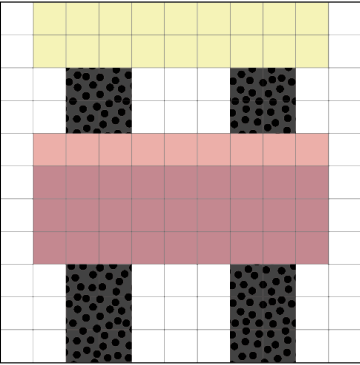
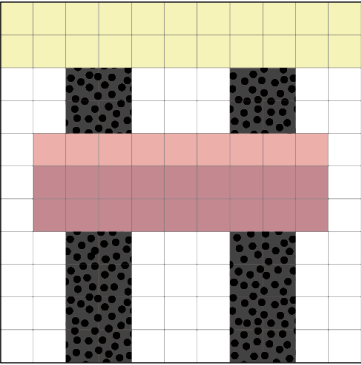
